Here is a quick introduction to the places
that you'll discover during Marimbazo Fest!

HOTEL MÓNACO



Hotel Mónaco is a comfortable, contemporary hotel near Reforma and downtown, and right around the corner from Foro Hilvana, one of the venues Son Rompe Pera calls home. This is the hotel where all of the band's buddies stay when they come to play in CDMX.

LA CAÑA



La Caña is the restaurant/bar/venue/cultural platform founded by Ali Gua Gua of Kumbia Queers + Ultrasónicas. Besides great seafood and party, it's the go-to place to discover the pulse of the emerging, alternative and countercultural music and arts scene in CDMX.

DISCOS Y AMIGOS CUMBIA TOUR



Your hosts for this trip will take you on their legendary cumbia tour & jam. You will learn the history of cumbia, how to dance it, and how to put together your own cumbianchero group.

CMLL 93 ANNIVERSARY SHOW



CMLL is the company that introduced Lucha Libre to Mexico City and the host of the biggest show in its history. In September they celebrate their 93th Anniversary with a sold out show where several mask vs mask battles will take place.

FORO HILVANA PRE-PARTY



Foro Hivana is a key venue for punk, world and alternative sounds in Mexico City. This where you would normally be able to catch shows from SRP, Chico Trujillo, La Mixanteña de Santa Cecilia, enjoy sunday salsa or son jarocho matinees and vinyl only parties.

EL CHOPO TIANGUIS CONTRACULTURAL



Founded in the 80s as a counter cultural market to exchange music and fanzines. El Chopo became a meeting ground for all rockers, punks and alternative culture heads during last century, when many juvenile art expressions where persecuted by the Government. Today it still stands as a bubbling cultural tianguis full of music and exciting things to discover.

THE BIG SHOW @ TEATRO METROPOLITAN



Featured in Oscar Winning "Roma" - Metropolitan opened in 1943 as a lavish Cinema in CDMX's downtown area. Today it's one of the most elegant concert rooms in the city. A place where emerging acts consolidate themselves into big timers. This the anchor of Marimbazo Fest, a grand event to celebrate Son Rompe Pera's connexion with its fans. STREET MURAL BIKE TOUR



The energy and legacy of Diego Rivera's famous murals laid strong roots in CDMX and today you can experience it through the thriving street mural scene that you can see all across the city. Led by Poray Bike Tours, this tour will let you discover some of the most fascinating artwork giving CDMX its identity. Some of it sometimes is hidden at plain sight.

LA LAGUNILLA ANTIQUES + ART TIANGUIS



Visiting La Lagunilla is taking a deep dive into the cultural heritage of CDMX. It feels a bit like London's Camden town, but to the nth power. The tianguis mixes antique stands, street galleries, alternative fashion shops, music bars and gourmet food. A very inspiring place for anyone interested in culture, art and having a great time.

SALÓN LOS ÁNGELES



"Those who don't know Salon Los Angeles don't know Mexico" - that's the tagline of Salon Los Angeles - and it's true. Los Angeles is CDMX's most legendary dance hall. It's where

Benny Moré composed "Bonito y Sabroso" on a napkin, where each week the most legendary Danzon orchestras play and where the new alternative artists throw their first big events. What's exciting about Los Angeles is that it combines the right mix of a varied crowd, commitment to culture and being a meeting point for some of the most exciting cultural minds of Mexico City and the world.
